## HOUSE BILL NO. 126

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-541, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1
- TO REQUIRE IDENTIFICATION OF ELECTORS BEFORE VOTING; TO REQUIRE
- ELECTORS TO SHOW A DRIVER'S LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY OR OTHER FORM OF LEGAL 3
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- IDENTIFICATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 23-15-541, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 8
- 23-15-541. At all elections, the polls shall be opened at 9
- seven o'clock in the morning and be kept open until seven o'clock 10
- in the evening and no longer. Upon the opening of the polls, and 11
- not before, the managers of the election shall designate two (2) 12
- of their number, other than the manager previously designated to 13
- receive the blank ballots, who shall \* \* \* be known respectively 14
- as the initialing manager and the alternate initialing manager. 15
- The alternate initialing manager, in the absence of the initialing 16
- manager, shall perform all of the duties and undertake all of the 17
- responsibilities of the initialing manager. When any person 18
- entitled to vote shall appear to vote, the managers shall identify 19
- the voter, in the presence and view of the bystanders, by 20
- requiring the voter to submit a valid Mississippi driver's 21
- 22 license, an identification card issued by the Department of Public
- Safety, a voter registration card, a health insurance card, a tax 23
- receipt, any other identification card issued by an agency of the 24
- state as provided by law, any identification card issued by an 25
- agency of the United States as provided by federal law, a 26
- 27 certified copy of the elector's birth certificate or any other
- severally recognized form or photographic identification or by 28

comparison with the descriptive information on the pollbook or by 29 30 having a person from the precinct vouch for the person's identification; and then that person shall sign his name in a 31 receipt book or booklet provided for that purpose and to be used 32 33 at that election only and the receipt book or booklet shall be 34 used in lieu of the list made by the managers or clerks which lists the voters who have voted formerly \* \* \*; whereupon and not 35 before, the initialing manager or, in his absence, the alternate 36 initialing manager shall indorse his initials on the back of an 37 official blank ballot, prepared in accordance with law, and at 38 39 such place on the back of the ballot that the initials may be seen after the ballot has been marked and folded, and when so indorsed 40 41 he shall deliver it to the voter, which ballot the voter shall mark in the manner provided by law, which when done the voter 42 shall deliver the same to the initialing manager or, in his 43 absence, to the alternate initialing manager, in the presence of 44 the others, and the manager shall see that the ballot so delivered 45 46 bears on the back thereof the genuine initials of the initialing manager, or alternate initialing manager, and if so, but not 47 otherwise, the ballot shall be put into the ballot box; and when 48 so done one (1) of the managers or a duly appointed clerk shall 49 50 make the proper entry on the pollbook. If the voter is unable to write his name on the receipt book, a manager or clerk shall note 51 on the back of the ballot that it was receipted for by his 52 53 assistance. SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 54 55 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the 56 57 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 58 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 59 60 extended.

- 61 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 62 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 63 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
