HOUSE BILL NO. 189

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.64, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT A PORTION OF THE ADDITIONAL FEES COLLECTED
- 3 FROM THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS IN SUPPORT OF THE
- 4 PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE
- 5 PETAL EDUCATION FOUNDATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 27-19-56.64, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 27-19-56.64. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a
- 10 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge
- 11 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
- 12 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
- 13 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
- 14 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
- 15 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor
- 16 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a
- 17 supporter of the Petal, Mississippi, School District. The
- 18 distinctive license tags so issued shall display the words "Petal
- 19 School District" and shall be of such color and design as the
- 20 State Tax Commission, with the advice of the Petal Education
- 21 Foundation, may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or
- 22 numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license
- 23 tag.
- 24 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
- 25 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
- 26 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the
- 27 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less
- 28 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,

- 29 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis
- 30 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional
- 31 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the
- 32 county general fund.
- 33 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
- 34 after July 1, 2002, any person applying for a distinctive license
- 35 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
- 36 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
- 37 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
- 38 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
- 39 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
- 40 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
- 41 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
- 42 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of
- 43 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive
- 44 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive
- 45 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax
- 46 collector.
- 47 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 48 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
- 49 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
- 50 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the
- 51 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State
- 52 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:
- 53 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
- 54 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
- 55 section shall be distributed to the Petal Education Foundation.
- 56 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
- 57 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
- 58 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
- 59 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.
- 60 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
- 61 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this

- 62 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
- 63 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
- 64 reconstruction of highways.
- (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
- on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
- 67 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
- 68 27-19-44.2.
- 69 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 70 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 71 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 72 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 73 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 74 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 75 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 76 tag.
- 77 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 78 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 79 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 80 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
- 81 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 82 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 83 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 84 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 85 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 86 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

- 88 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 89 and after its passage.
