HOUSE BILL NO. 197

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 27-19-56.12, 27-19-56.36, 27-19-56.38, 27-19-56.42, 27-19-56.48, 27-19-56.49, 27-19-56.50, 27-19-56.51 AND 27-19-56.62, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE ADDITIONAL FEE CHARGED FOR THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN 3 4 DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAGS RELATING TO THE MILITARY 5 SHALL BE A ONE-TIME FEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.12, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:
- 10 27-19-56.12. In recognition of the patriotic service
- rendered by Mississippians who are honorably discharged veterans 11
- who served in the United States Armed Forces, any such person is 12
- privileged to obtain distinctive motor vehicle license plates or 13
- tags for each motor vehicle registered in his name identifying his 14
- status as a veteran. The State Tax Commission, with concurrence 15
- by the State Veterans Affairs Board, shall develop decals to be 16
- 17 affixed to the license tag indicating branch and period of
- military service. The distinctive plates or tags shall be of a 18
- color and design designated by the Tax Commission with concurrence 19
- by the State Veterans Affairs Board. 20
- The distinctive license plates shall be prepared by the Tax 21
- Commission and shall be issued through the tax collectors of the 22
- counties in the same manner as are other motor vehicle license 23
- plates or tags. An additional one-time tag fee of Thirty Dollars 24
- (\$30.00) shall be collected by the tax collector for such license 25
- plates or tags and shall be remitted to the Tax Commission on a 26
- 27 monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The additional fee
- is due and payable at the time the original application is made 28
- for a distinctive tag under this section * * *. The State Tax 29

- 30 Commission shall deposit such fee to the credit of a fund to be
- 31 administered by the board overseeing the veterans nursing homes in
- 32 this state for the benefit of indigent veterans who are residents
- 33 of such nursing homes.
- 34 An applicant for such distinctive plates shall present to the
- 35 issuing official written evidence of the veteran's service. Such
- 36 evidence shall include a copy of the applicant's DD-214 form, a
- 37 Report of Separation from Military Service, a military discharge
- 38 document, or a written certification of military service from the
- 39 State Veterans Affairs Board. The distinctive license plates or
- 40 tags so issued shall be used only upon a personally or jointly
- 41 owned private passenger vehicle (to include station wagons,
- 42 recreational motor vehicles and pickup trucks) registered in the
- 43 name, or jointly in the name, of the person making application
- 44 therefor, and when issued to such person shall be used upon the
- 45 vehicle for which issued in lieu of the standard license plate or
- 46 license tag normally issued for such vehicle.
- The distinctive license plates shall not be transferable
- 48 between motor vehicle owners; and in the event the owner of a
- 49 vehicle bearing a distinctive plate shall sell, trade, exchange or
- 50 otherwise dispose of the vehicle, such plate shall be retained by
- 51 such owner and returned to the tax collector.
- 52 **SECTION 2.** Section 27-19-56.36, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 53 amended as follows:
- 54 27-19-56.36. (1) In recognition of the patriotic services
- 55 rendered the United States, Mississippi and the citizens thereof,
- 56 any resident of the state who is on active duty with the Armed
- 57 Forces of the United States, upon payment of the road and bridge
- 58 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
- 59 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
- 60 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of
- an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
- 62 section, shall be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate

or tag identifying him as an active duty member of the United

64 States Armed Forces. The distinctive license tags so issued shall

65 be of such color and design as the State Tax Commission may

75 retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax

76 Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission.

79 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or

after July 1, 2003, any person applying for a distinctive license

tag under this section shall pay \underline{a} one-time additional fee in the
