- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) It shall be unlawful to rent any room in a
- 6 hotel as that term is defined in Section 41-49-3 to any person for
- 7 less than twenty-four (24) hours, except for organizational
- 8 conferences, receptions or meeting purposes.
- 9 (2) Any person or entity that commits a first violation of
- 10 the provisions of subsection (1) upon conviction shall be fined
- 11 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than
- 12 one (1) year, or both. For a second or subsequent offense, upon
- 13 conviction such person or entity shall be fined Five Thousand
- 14 Dollars (\$5,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than three (3)
- 15 years, or both.
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after July 1, 2003.
