- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-16-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 REQUIRE THAT STUDENTS COMPLETE A STATE CERTIFIED DRIVER EDUCATION
- 3 TRAINING PROGRAM IN ORDER TO GRADUATE FROM HIGH SCHOOL; AND FOR
- 4 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37-16-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-16-7. (1) Each district school board shall establish
- 9 standards for graduation from its schools which shall include as a
- 10 minimum:
- 11 (a) Mastery of minimum academic skills as measured by
- 12 assessments developed and administered by the State Board of
- 13 Education.
- 14 (b) Completion of a minimum number of academic credits,
- 15 and all other applicable requirements prescribed by the district
- 16 school board.
- 17 (c) For high schools, completion of a state certified
- 18 driver education and training program.
- 19 (2) A student who meets all requirements prescribed in
- 20 subsection (1) of this section shall be awarded a standard diploma
- 21 in a form prescribed by the state board.
- 22 (3) The State Board of Education may establish student
- 23 proficiency standards for promotion to grade levels leading to
- 24 graduation.
- 25 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2003.
