- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** In addition to the curriculum otherwise required
- 6 by law or the State Board of Education to be taught in the public
- 7 schools of this state, a comprehensive course in Mississippi
- 8 History is required for all ninth grade students. The objective
- 9 of the Mississippi History course must be to provide students with
- 10 an examination of the history of the State of Mississippi from the
- 11 age of discovery and colonization to the present with particular
- 12 emphasis on the significant political, social, economic and
- 13 cultural issues of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries which
- 14 have impacted the diverse ethnic and racial populations of the
- 15 state.
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after July 1, 2003.
