- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-15-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 37-15-1. The State Board of Education shall prepare and
- 8 provide necessary forms for keeping permanent records and
- 9 cumulative folders for each pupil in the public schools of the
- 10 state. In the permanent record and cumulative folders, the
- 11 teachers and principals shall keep information concerning the
- 12 pupil's date of birth, as verified by the documentation authorized
- 13 in this section, record of attendance, grades and withdrawal from
- 14 the school, including the date of any expulsion from the school
- 15 system and a description of the student's act or behavior
- 16 resulting in the expulsion. The records also shall contain
- 17 information pertaining to immunization and such other information
- 18 as the State Board of Education may prescribe. The cumulative
- 19 folder, in addition to that information maintained in the
- 20 permanent records, also shall contain such other information as
- 21 the State Board of Education shall prescribe. It shall be the
- 22 responsibility of the person in charge of each school to enforce
- 23 the requirement for evidence of the age of each pupil before
- 24 enrollment. If the first prescribed evidence is not available,
- 25 the next evidence obtainable in the order set forth below shall be
- 26 accepted:
- 27 (a) A certified birth certificate;

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- 28 (b) A duly attested transcript of a certificate of
- 29 baptism showing the date of birth and place of baptism of the
- 30 child, accompanied by an affidavit sworn to by a parent,
- 31 grandparent or custodian;
- 32 (c) An insurance policy on the child's life which has
- 33 been in force for at least two (2) years;
- 34 (d) A bona fide contemporary Bible record of the
- 35 child's birth accompanied by an affidavit sworn to by the parent,
- 36 grandparent or custodian;
- 37 (e) A passport or certificate of arrival in the United
- 38 States showing the age of the child;
- 39 (f) A transcript of record of age shown in the child's
- 40 school record of at least four (4) years prior to application,
- 41 stating date of birth; or
- 42 (g) If none of these evidences can be produced, an
- 43 affidavit of age sworn to by a parent, grandparent or custodian.
- 44 Any child enrolling in Kindergarten or Grade 1 shall present the
- 45 required evidence of age upon enrollment. Any child in Grades 2
- 46 through 12 not in compliance at the end of sixty (60) days from
- 47 enrollment shall be suspended until in compliance.
- This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2004.
- 49 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after July 1, 2003.
