HOUSE BILL NO. 772

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 67-3-74, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 EXTEND THE REPEALER ON THE AUTHORITY OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL 3 OFFICERS TO ENFORCE LAWS REGULATING WINE AND BEER; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 67-3-74, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

67-3-74. (1) In addition to peace officers within their 8 9 jurisdiction, all enforcement officers of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division of the State Tax Commission are authorized to 10 enforce the provisions made unlawful by Sections 67-3-13, 67-3-15, 11 67-3-53 and 67-3-70; provided, however, that the provisions 12 prohibiting the sale of light wine or beer to persons under the 13 age of twenty-one (21) years shall be enforced by the division as 14 provided for in this section. 15

(2) (a) The Alcoholic Beverage Control Division shall
investigate violations of the laws prohibiting the sale of light
wine or beer to persons under the age of twenty-one (21) years
upon receipt of a complaint or information from a person stating
that they have knowledge of such violation.

(b) Upon receipt of such complaint or information, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division shall notify the permit holder of the complaint by certified mail to the primary business office of such permit holder or by hand delivery of the complaint or information to the primary business office of such holder, except in cases where the complaint or information is received from any law enforcement officer.

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If an enforcement officer of the Alcoholic Beverage (C) 28 Control Division enters the business of the holder of the permit 29 to investigate a complaint and discovers a violation, the agent 30 31 shall notify the person that committed the violation and the 32 holder of the permit: (i) Within ten (10) days after such violation, 33 Sundays and holidays excluded, if the business sells light wine or 34 beer for on-premises consumption; and 35 (ii) Within seventy-two (72) hours after such 36 violation, Sundays and holidays excluded, if the business does not 37 38 sell light wine or beer for on-premises consumption. (3) The provisions of this section shall be repealed on July 39 40 1, 2004. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 41

42 and after July 1, 2003.

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
