AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-13-407, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO DIRECT THE STATE TREASURER TO DEPOSIT THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE 2 2003 TOBACCO SETTLEMENT INSTALLMENT PAYMENT RECEIVED BY THE STATE 3 4 INTO THE HEALTH CARE EXPENDABLE FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 43-13-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 43-13-407. (1) In accordance with the purposes of this 8 9 article, there is established in the State Treasury the Health Care Expendable Fund, into which shall be transferred from the 10 Health Care Trust Fund the following sums: 11 (a) In fiscal year 2000, Fifty Million Dollars 12 (\$50,000,000.00); 13 In fiscal year 2001, Fifty-five Million Dollars (b) 14 (\$55,000,000.00);15 In fiscal year 2002, Sixty Million Five Hundred 16 (C) 17 Thousand Dollars (\$60,500,000.00); In fiscal year 2003, Sixty-six Million Five Hundred 18 (d) Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$66,550,000.00); 19 In fiscal year 2004 and each subsequent fiscal (e) 20 year, a sum equal to the average annual amount of the income from 21 the investment of the funds in the Health Care Trust Fund since 22 23 July 1, 1999. In any fiscal year in which interest and dividends from 24 (2)the investment of the funds in the Health Care Trust Fund are not 25 sufficient to fund the full amount of the annual transfer into the 26 Health Care Expendable Fund as required in subsection (1) of this 27 section, the State Treasurer shall transfer from tobacco 28 H. 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29 settlement installment payments an amount that is sufficient to 30 fully fund the amount of the annual transfer.

On March 6, 2002, the State Treasurer shall 31 (3) (a) 32 transfer the sum of Eighty-seven Million Dollars (\$87,000,000.00) 33 from the Health Care Trust Fund into the Health Care Expendable 34 Fund. In addition, at the time the State of Mississippi receives the 2002 calendar year tobacco settlement installment payment, the 35 State Treasurer shall deposit the full amount of that installment 36 payment into the Health Care Expendable Fund, and at the time the 37 38 State of Mississippi receives the 2003 calendar year tobacco 39 settlement installment payment, the State Treasurer shall deposit the full amount of that installment payment into the Health Care 40 Expendable Fund. 41

If during any fiscal year after March 6, 2002, the 42 (b) general fund revenues received by the state exceed the general 43 fund revenues received during the previous fiscal year by more 44 than five percent (5%), the Legislature shall repay to the Health 45 46 Care Trust Fund one-third (1/3) of the amount of the general fund revenues that exceed the five percent (5%) growth in general fund 47 48 The repayment required by this paragraph shall continue revenues. in each fiscal year in which there is more than five percent (5%) 49 50 growth in general fund revenues, until the full amount of the funds that were transferred and deposited into the Health Care 51 Expendable Fund under the provisions of paragraph (a) of this 52 53 subsection have been repaid to the Health Care Trust Fund.

(4) All income from the investment of the funds in the
Health Care Expendable Fund shall be credited to the account of
the Health Care Expendable Fund. Any funds in the Health Care
Expendable Fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into
the State General Fund.

59 (5) The funds in the Health Care Expendable Fund shall be60 available for expenditure under specific appropriation by the

(6) Subsections (1), (2), (4) and (5) of this section shall
stand repealed on July 1, 2004.
