## HOUSE BILL NO. 850

AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT TO HIRE ADDITIONAL SOCIAL WORKERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2003.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** In addition to all other sums previously
- 6 appropriated, the following sum, or so much of it as may be
- 7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
- 8 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Human
- 9 Services for the purposes specified in Section 2 of this act for
- 10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003.....\$1,105,000.00.
- 11 **SECTION 2.** (1) This additional appropriation is made for
- 12 the purpose of providing additional funds to the Department of
- 13 Human Services to enable the department to hire additional social
- 14 workers, in accordance with the provisions of this section. This
- 15 act shall apply only to Department of Human Services social worker
- 16 occupational classes and their supervisors.
- 17 (2) The funds appropriated by this act may be expended only
- 18 when the average caseload per social worker in a county is fifty
- 19 (50) or more. When that caseload situation exists, the Department
- 20 of Human Services shall use the funds appropriated by this act (a)
- 21 to increase the starting salary of social worker new hires by up
- 22 to five percent (5%), and (b) for equity and retention purposes,
- 23 to increase the salaries of existing social workers and their
- 24 supervisors by up to five percent (5%).

- 25 **SECTION 3.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 26 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund
- 27 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State
- 28 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his
- 29 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
- 30 officers in the manner provided by law.
- 31 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after its passage.
