- 1368 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
- 1369 27-19-44.2.
- 1370 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 1371 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 1372 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 1373 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under

this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license tag.

1378 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 1379 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 1380 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 1381 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 1382 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 1383 1384 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 1385 1386 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this section. 1387

1388 SECTION 17. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, fees collected from the issuance of distinctive 1389 1390 or special license tags under this chapter which are designated 1391 for deposit into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70, shall be placed 1392 1393 into an interest bearing escrow account until the Attorney General requests the State Tax Commission to release such funds. 1394 1395 Attorney General shall not request the release of such funds until he is satisfied that there is proper accountability for the 1396 expenditure of the funds by Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial 1397 1398 Burn Center.

1399 (2) The Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn Center
1400 shall file an annual report with the Secretary of the Senate and
1401 the Clerk of the House of Representatives not later than January
1402 10 of each year, describing the expenditure of funds received by
1403 the burn center from fees collected from the issuance of
1404 distinctive or special license tags under this chapter.

- 1425 **SECTION 19.** Section 27-19-56.10, Mississippi Code of 1972,
- 1426 is amended as follows:
- 1427 27-19-56.10. (1) Owners of motor vehicles upon complying
- 1428 with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing
- 1429 of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and bridge
- 1430 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
- 1431 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
- 1432 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of

- Application for the special license tags shall be made 1440 1441 to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee, less five 1442 1443 percent (5%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be 1444 remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as 1445 prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county 1446 general fund. 1447
- 1448 (4) The special license tag shall be issued for a one-year 1449 period. The additional annual fee shall be due and payable at the 1450 time of renewal registration.
- 1451 (5) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 1452 State Treasury on the day received. At the end of each month, the 1453 State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected under 1454 this section to the State Treasurer who shall distribute such 1455 collections as follows:
- Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of each additional fee 1456 (a) 1457 collected on special license tags issued pursuant to this section shall be deposited into the Wildlife Heritage Fund created 1458 1459 pursuant to Section 49-5-77. However, such additional fees collected from the issuance of distinctive license tags from and 1460 1461 after July 1, 2003, displaying an emblem depicting any salt water species shall be deposited into the Coastal Preserve Account in 1462 the Seafood Fund created pursuant to Section 49-15-17. 1463
- 1464 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 1465 on special license tags shall be deposited into the Mississippi 1466 Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn Center Fund created pursuant to 1467 Section 7-9-70.
- 1468 (c) The remainder of each such additional fee shall be
 1469 deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund to be expended
 1470 solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or reconstruction
 1471 of highways.

SECTION 20. Section 49-15-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 1472 1473 amended as follows:

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49-15-17. (1) (a) All monies received or obtained by the commission under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid over by the commission to the State Treasurer and shall be deposited into the fund known as the "Seafood Fund." All revenues collected through the department, to include, but not limited to, commercial saltwater licenses and taxes, permits, fines and penalties, and confiscated catches, shall be deposited into the department operating account (Seafood Fund) and expended for the operation of the department, as authorized by the Legislature.

There is established a special account to be known as the "Artificial Reef Program Account" within the seafood fund. Any funds received from any public or private source for the purpose of promoting, constructing, monitoring or maintaining artificial reefs in the marine waters of the state or in federal waters adjacent to the marine waters of the state shall be credited to the account. Any unexpended funds remaining in the account at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into the seafood fund, but shall remain in the account. The department may expend any funds in the account, subject to appropriation by the Legislature, to accomplish the purpose of the account.

There is established a special account to be known 1494 as the "Coastal Preserve Account" within the seafood fund. 1495 1496 funds received from any public or private source for the purpose of management, improvement and acquisition of coastal preserves in 1497 1498 the state and money required to be deposited pursuant to Sections 27-19-56.10 and 27-19-56.27, shall be credited to the account. 1499 Any unexpended funds remaining in the account at the end of the 1500 1501 fiscal year shall not lapse into the seafood fund, but shall 1502 remain in the account. The department may expend any funds in the 1503 account, subject to appropriation by the Legislature, for the management, improvement and acquisition of coastal preserves. 1504

- 1507 (3) The secretary of the commission shall keep accurate
 1508 reports of monies handled as a part of the permanent records of
 1509 the commission, and the State Treasurer shall furnish the
 1510 secretary of the commission such forms as may be needed, and the
 1511 secretary shall account for such forms in his reports to the
 1512 treasurer.
- SECTION <u>21</u>. Section 17 of this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. The remainder of this act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2003.
