HOUSE BILL NO. 966

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS 1 IN SUPPORT OF ANY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE STATE; TO PROVIDE 2 3 FOR THE IMPOSITION OF AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH LICENSE TAGS; TO PROVIDE FOR DISTRIBUTION OF THE ADDITIONAL FEES COLLECTED; TO REPEAL SECTIONS 27-19-56.64, 27-19-56.65 AND 4 5 27-19-56.66, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH AUTHORIZE THE 6 ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE TAGS IN SUPPORT OF 7 THE PETAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE DESOTO COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE SIMPSON COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT; TO PROVIDE THAT ANY MONIES IN 8 9 THE SPECIAL FUNDS CREATED UNDER THESE REPEALED SECTIONS SHALL BE 10 TRANSFERRED TO THE STATE TREASURY AND PAID BY THE STATE TREASURER 11 TO THE SCHOOL BOARDS OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN SUPPORT OF 12 WHICH DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAGS ARE ISSUED UNDER THIS ACT; AND FOR 13 14 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 15 SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 16 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 17 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 18 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 19 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 20 21 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 22 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 23 supporter of any public school district in the state. 24 The distinctive license tags so issued shall display the name of the 25 school district and shall be of such color and design as the State 26 Tax Commission may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or 27 28 numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license 29 taq.

Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 30 (2) 31 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 32 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 33 H. B. No. 966

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Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the county general fund.

39 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or (3) after July 1, 2003, any person applying for a distinctive license 40 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 41 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 42 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 43 44 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 45 46 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive license 47 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 48 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 49 50 license taq. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 51 collector. 52

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee 59 (a) 60 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall be paid to the school board of the public school 61 district in support of which the tag is issued, and such monies 62 when so received, may be expended, as authorized and directed by 63 the school board, for classroom supplies, instructional materials 64 65 and equipment, including computers and computer software and other classroom needs of the public schools of the district. 66

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(b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

(c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
reconstruction of highways.

(d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
27-19-44.2.

(5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 80 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 81 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 82 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 83 84 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 85 86 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 87 tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 88 (6) tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 89 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 90 91 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 92 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 93 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 94 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 95 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 96 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 97

98 (7) The provisions of this section shall not be applicable 99 to those school districts for which distinctive license tags are

102 SECTION 2. Sections 27-19-56.64, 27-19-56.65 and 103 27-19-56.66, Mississippi Code of 1972, which authorize the 104 issuance of distinctive motor vehicle license tags in support of 105 the Petal School District, the Desoto County School District and 106 the Simpson County School District, are repealed.

SECTION 3. Any monies in the special funds created under 107 subsection (7) of Section 27-19-56.64, subsection (7) of Section 108 27-19-56.65 and subsection (7) of Section 27-19-56.66, shall be 109 110 transferred to the State Treasury and, in accordance with the provisions of subsection (4)(a) of Section 1 of House Bill No. 111 112 , 2003 Regular Session, shall be paid by the State Treasurer to the school boards of the public school districts in support of 113 which distinctive license tags are issued under Section 1 of House 114 Bill No. ____, 2003 Regular Session. 115

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2003.
