COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 979

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 93-21-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES A DOMESTIC ABUSE 1 2 3 PROTECTIVE ORDER ISSUED BY A MISSISSIPPI COURT OR FOREIGN COURT OF 4 COMPETENT JURISDICTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR; TO PROVIDE THAT VIOLATORS SHALL EITHER BE HELD IN CONTEMPT OR PUNISHED FOR A 5 MISDEMEANOR; TO AUTHORIZE A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO ARREST SUCH 6 PERSON WITH OR WITHOUT AN ARREST WARRANT; TO DELETE THE PENALTY 7 FOR A PERSON WHO VIOLATES A COURT APPROVED CONSENT AGREEMENT REGARDING DOMESTIC ABUSE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 11 SECTION 1. Section 93-21-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 12 93-21-21. Upon a knowing violation of a protective order 13 issued after a hearing or an ex parte protective order, either of 14 15 which was issued for the purpose of protecting the victim from 16 abuse as defined by Section 93-21-3(a), whether the order was issued by a Mississippi court or a foreign court of competent 17 jurisdiction, the person violating such order commits a 18 misdemeanor or the court may hold the person in contempt. If the 19 court convicts the person of a misdemeanor, the court may \* \* \* 20 21 punish the defendant by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6) months or a fine of not more than One Thousand 22 Dollars (\$1,000.00), or both. A person shall not be convicted of 23 24 and held in contempt for the same violation of an order. Any law 25 enforcement officer has the authority to make an arrest for such 26 violation, either with a warrant or without a warrant pursuant to Section 99-3-7, when he has probable cause to believe that a 27 violation has been committed which is an act of domestic violence 28

29 or is a violation of an order and has been committed within

## 30 twenty-four (24) hours of the arrest as described in Section

31 99-3-7.

## 32 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 33 and after July 1, 2003.
