- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 99-5-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 CLARIFY THAT THE TWENTY-FOUR-HOUR WAITING PERIOD FOR COURT
- 3 APPEARANCES FOR ACTS OF MISDEMEANOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INCLUDES
- 4 WEEKENDS AND HOLIDAYS; TO LIMIT BAIL SETTINGS TO MISDEMEANOR
- 5 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 99-5-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 99-5-37. In any arrest for a misdemeanor which is an act of
- 10 domestic violence, as defined in Section 97-3-7, no bail shall be
- 11 granted until the person arrested has appeared before a judge of
- 12 the court of competent jurisdiction. The defendant shall be
- 13 brought before a judge at the first reasonable opportunity, not to
- 14 exceed twenty-four (24) hours from the time of the arrest. In
- 15 calculating the twenty-four (24) hours, weekends and holidays
- 16 shall be included. The appearance may be by telephone. Upon
- 17 setting bail in any case involving a misdemeanor which is an act
- 18 of domestic violence, the judge shall give particular
- 19 consideration to the exigencies of the case, including the
- 20 potential for further violence, and shall impose any specific
- 21 conditions as he or she may deem necessary.
- 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2003.
