HOUSE BILL NO. 1043

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO ALLOW A PERSON WHO MOVES FROM ONE WARD OR PRECINCT TO ANOTHER 2 3 WARD OR PRECINCT IN THE STATE TO TRANSFER HIS REGISTRATION TO THE 4 NEW WARD OR PRECINCT; TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-573, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, to CONFORM WITH THE PRECEDING SECTION; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. 6

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 23-15-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 9

10 23-15-13. An elector who moves from one ward or voting precinct to another ward in the state shall not be disqualified to 11 vote, but he or she shall be entitled to have his or her 12 registration transferred to his or her new ward or voting precinct 13 upon making written request therefor at any time up to thirty (30) 14 days prior to the election at which he or she offers to vote, and 15 if the removal occurs within thirty (30) days of such election he 16 or she shall be entitled to vote in his or her new ward or voting 17 precinct by affidavit ballot as provided in Section 23-15-573. 18

SECTION 2. Section 23-15-573, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 19 20 amended as follows:

23-15-573. Any person whose name does not appear upon the 21 pollbooks shall be permitted to vote in an election; but if any 22 person offering to vote in any election whose name does not appear 23 upon the pollbook shall make affidavit before one (1) of the 24 managers of election in writing that he is entitled to vote, or 25 that he has been illegally denied registration, his vote may be 26 27 prepared by him and handed to the proper election officer who shall enclose the same in an envelope with the written affidavit 28 of the voter, seal the envelope and mark plainly upon it the name 29 H. 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of the person offering to vote. The affidavit must include the 30 31 complete name, all required addresses and telephone numbers, and the signature of the affiant, and must include the signature of 32 33 one (1) of the election managers. A separate register shall be 34 maintained for affidavit ballots, and the affiant shall sign the register upon completing an affidavit under this section. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 86 87 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the 88 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 89 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 90 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 91 extended. 92

93 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 94 and after October 1, 2003, if it is effectuated on or before that 95 date under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended H. B. No. 1043

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96 and extended. If it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 97 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended, after October 1 2003, 98 this act shall take effect and be in force from and after the date 99 it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 100 1965, as amended and extended.
