HOUSE BILL NO. 1078

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-45, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1
- PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO SNARE, TRAP, CATCH 2
- OR CAPTURE ANY DEER, IN OR OUT OF SEASON; TO PRESCRIBE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 3

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 49-7-45, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 49-7-45. (1) It is unlawful for any person: 8
- 9 (i) To hunt, chase, kill or to pursue with the
- intent to take, kill or wound any wild animal or wild bird in 10
- violation of this chapter; 11
- (ii) To hunt, take, kill or wound any game animal 12
- or game bird with a gun larger than 10 gauge; 13
- (iii) To hunt, take, wound or shoot at any game 14
- 15 bird:
- From any motorboat or other craft having 16 (A)
- 17 a motor attached unless the motor has been completely shut off and
- its progress has ceased. A craft under power may be used to 18
- retrieve dead or crippled birds; however, crippled birds may not 19
- be shot from a craft under power; or 20
- (B) From any sinkbox or battery except in 21
- waters of the Gulf Coast. 22
- 23 To wound, drown, shoot, capture, take or otherwise
- kill any deer from a boat. 24
- To lend or transfer or borrow or to use or display 25
- 26 while hunting, trapping or fishing, a license or tag of another.

- 27 (d) To aid in the securing of a license for or to
- 28 knowingly issue a license for any person not legally entitled to
- 29 same.
- 30 (e) To hunt, trap or fish in this state after the right
- 31 to do so has been denied by the commission or the license therefor
- 32 has been revoked.
- 33 (f) To hunt or trap any birds, game or wild animals
- 34 during the closed season.
- 35 (g) To snare, trap, catch or capture any deer, in or
- 36 out of season.
- 37 (h) Any person violating paragraphs (b), (f) or (g) is
- 38 guilty of a Class II offense and shall be punished as provided in
- 39 Section 49-7-143.
- 40 (2) Any citation issued to a boat operator for not
- 41 registering or possessing the boat's registration card shall be
- 42 dismissed, along with all related court costs if the boat operator
- 43 can verify that the boat was properly registered prior to the date
- 44 of violation. A boat operator may submit a copy of his or her
- 45 boat's proper registration card, certified by the clerk or
- 46 magistrate of the court holding the trial or hearing, along with
- 47 all related court costs, to the court or magistrate before the
- 48 date of the trial or hearing and the citation shall be dismissed
- 49 under this subsection without the boat operator or the boat
- 50 operator's counsel being present.
- 51 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 52 and after July 1, 2003.
