BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 7 SECTION 1. Section 37-41-55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 8

- 9 37-41-55. The driver of every school transportation vehicle
- used to transport pupils, on approaching any railroad crossing or 10
- highway intersection shall bring the vehicle to a complete stop 11
- and shall not proceed until the driver of such vehicle has 12
- determined that it is safe to proceed. In addition, the driver 13
- 14 shall open the service door and driver's window and look and
- listen for an approaching train at all railroad crossings. Any 15
- driver who shall fail to bring his vehicle to a complete stop as 16
- herein required shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon 17
- conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than Twenty-five 18
- 19 Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for
- 20 each such offense.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 21
- 22 and after July 1, 2003.
