## HOUSE BILL NO. 1171

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION ON MARINE RESOURCES TO ESTABLISH A
- 3 PROGRAM TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF LICENSES AND OTHER
- 4 DOCUMENTS ELECTRONICALLY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 49-15-29. (1) The commission shall assess and collect
- 9 license fees and taxes as authorized under this chapter.
- 10 (2) All commercial licenses provided for under this chapter
- 11 that relate to seafood shall be purchased from May 1 through April
- 12 30 at the fees provided in this chapter. The licenses shall
- 13 expire on April 30 following the date of issuance.
- 14 (3) When an application for an original or renewal license
- 15 of any kind authorized by this chapter is received by the
- 16 commission, the commission shall determine whether the vessel or
- 17 related equipment subject to that license is owned and operated in
- 18 compliance with applicable federal and state laws. If the
- 19 commission determines that a vessel or its owner is not in
- 20 compliance with applicable federal and state laws, then no license
- 21 shall be issued or renewed for the operation of that vessel for a
- 22 period of one (1) year. All licenses shall be made available for
- 23 purchase at any building which is regularly operated by the
- 24 department or commission on the Mississippi Gulf Coast.

- 25 (4) The commission may authorize any person, other than a
- 26 salaried employee of the state to issue any license under this
- 27 chapter which the commission deems appropriate. The authorized
- 28 person may collect and retain for issuance of the license the sum

- 29 of One Dollar (\$1.00) in addition to the license fee provided in
- 30 this chapter. The commission shall establish the qualifications
- 31 of persons authorized to issue licenses under this section and
- 32 shall also establish the procedure for the issuance of that
- 33 license by the authorized person and the procedure for collection
- 34 of license fees by and from the authorized person.
- 35 (5) The commission may design, establish, and administer a
- 36 program to provide for the purchase, by electronic means, of any
- 37 license, permit, registration or reservation issued by the
- 38 commission or department. Any actual costs associated to provide
- 39 these documents electronically may be added to the cost of the
- 40 electronic program.
- 41 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 2003.
