HOUSE BILL NO. 1172

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-315, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO BROADEN THE AREA OF WATER PROTECTED FROM COMMERCIAL HARVESTING 1

- OF VARIOUS SEAFOOD BY DELETING THE REFERENCE TO THE PASCAGOULA 3 4 RIVER SYSTEM AND JACKSON COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 49-15-315, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 8 49-15-315. (1) It is unlawful for any person, firm or
- 9 corporation to engage in commercial harvesting of crabs, oysters,
- shrimp, bait shrimp or saltwater fish * * * north of the CSX 10
- Railroad in * * * Mississippi, except for the following: 11
- 12 (a) A person may take any euryhaline species of minnow;
- and 13
- A person may take live bait shrimp between the 14
- hours of sunrise and sunset on Friday, Saturday and Sunday in the 15
- West Pascagoula River System when opened by the department after 16
- sampling studies. 17
- (2) A person may take live bait shrimp between the hours of 18
- sunrise and 12:00 noon in the Back Bay of Biloxi when opened by 19
- the department after sampling studies. 20
- The Gulf Coast Research Laboratory shall study all 21
- estuaries and bays deemed to be nurseries. The Gulf Coast 22
- Research Laboratory may recommend the establishment of nursery 23
- grounds in the estuaries and bays if necessary to protect the 24
- state's fishing resources. 25
- 26 The department shall set the limits on all catches for
- noncommercial use. 27

28	(5) A person, firm or corporation found guilty of violating
29	this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined as
30	provided in Section 49-15-100(2), or imprisoned not more than
31	three (3) months or both; and in addition, the commission shall
32	seize and confiscate all commercial nets, trawls, traps, tongs and
33	boats used for such purpose and dispose of it at public sale and
34	shall deposit the proceeds to the credit of the Seafood Fund. If
35	the person in possession of or using the nets in the violation is
36	not the owner or licensee of the nets, the department shall notify
37	the owner or licensee of the nets. The nets shall be subject to
38	forfeiture unless the nets were stolen and prosecution for the
39	theft is initiated.
40	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2003.
