HOUSE BILL NO. 1245

- AN ACT TO CREATE A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF MERGING VARIOUS STATE HEALTH CARE PROGRAMS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPOSITION OF THE TASK FORCE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE TASK FORCE SHALL MAKE A REPORT OF ITS WORK TO THE LEGISLATURE AND THE 3

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is created a task force to study the
- feasibility of merging various state health care programs and 8
- 9 developing a comprehensive plan of service that would provide the
- services currently provided by those health care programs. 10
- state health care programs that the task force shall study are the 11
- Medicaid program, the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) 12
- and the State and School Employees Health Insurance Program, and 13
- 14 the task force may include other state health care programs in its
- study as deemed appropriate. 15
- The task force shall be composed of nine (9) members, as 16
- follows: 17
- The Chairs of the Public Health and Welfare (a) 18
- Committee and the Insurance Committee of the House of 19
- 20 Representatives;
- The Chairs of the Public Health and Welfare 21
- 22 Committee and the Insurance Committee of the Senate; and
- 23 Five (5) persons appointed by the Governor.
- At its first meeting, the task force shall elect a chair 24
- and vice chair from its membership, and shall adopt rules for 25
- transacting its business and keeping records. Members of the task 26
- 27 force shall receive a per diem in the amount provided in Section
- 25-3-69 for each day engaged in the business of the task force. 28

- 29 Members of the task force other than the legislative members shall
- 30 receive reimbursement for travel expenses incurred while engaged
- 31 in official business of the task force in accordance with Section
- 32 25-3-41, and the legislative members of the task force shall
- 33 receive the expense allowance provided for in Section 5-1-47.
- 34 (4) Not later than December 1, 2003, the task force shall
- 35 make a report of its work and recommendations, and shall submit a
- 36 copy of the report to the Legislature and the Governor.
- 37 (5) The task force shall be assigned to the Governor's
- 38 Office for administrative purposes only, and the Governor's Office
- 39 shall designate staff to assist the task force. The task force
- 40 may solicit grants, donations and other funds, and may accept and
- 41 expend any funds that are made available to the task force to
- 42 carry out its purpose.
- 43 (6) All agencies, departments, offices and institutions of
- 44 the state, including the state universities and the community and
- 45 junior colleges, shall cooperate with the task force with such
- 46 assistance as requested by the task force.
- 47 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 48 and after July 1, 2003.
