HOUSE BILL NO. 1267

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 51-29-17, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO PROVIDE THAT COMMISSIONERS OF WATER DRAINAGE DISTRICTS SHALL
- 3 RECEIVE MILEAGE AND TRAVEL EXPENSES ALLOWED TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES;
- 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51-29-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 51-29-17. The commissioners appointed as aforesaid shall
- 9 hold their offices, one (1) for two (2) years, one (1) for four
- 10 (4) years, and one (1) for six (6) years, from the date of their
- 11 appointment and until their successors are appointed and
- 12 qualified. On the expiration of their terms of office, their
- 13 successors shall be appointed in like manner for the term of six
- 14 (6) years thereafter. They shall hold their meetings at any time
- 15 and place in the county or counties in which any part of the
- 16 district is situated, upon the call of the president.
- 17 The commissioners herein provided for shall receive per diem
- 18 compensation as provided by Section 25-3-69, together with mileage
- 19 and other travel expenses as provided in Section 25-3-41 for
- 20 public employees in the performance of their official duties.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2003.
