Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to fifty percent (50%) of the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 37 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 38 39 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 40 41 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 42 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 43 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish 44 separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002, data, 45 46 for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 47 48 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 49 50 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for 51 "Personal Services," as annualized on a semiannual basis in 52 53 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 54 55 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 56 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 57 58 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce 59 the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 60 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 61

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

68 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 69 and after its passage.
