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Variable Compensation Plan or Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), 129 whichever is greater, beginning on January 1, 2003. 130 131 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 132 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 133 Services" for Fiscal Year 2004 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2003 134 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs, positions or 135 pay increases are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi 136 Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget 137 138 Office, the State Personnel Board shall, on July 1, 2002, publish separate annual projection reports, based on July 1, 2002, data, 139 140 for the period of July 1, 2002, through December 31, 2002, and January 1, 2003, through June 30, 2003, that project the annual 141 cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with 142 the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 143 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 144 145 this projected cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2003 appropriation for "Personal Services," as annualized on a semiannual basis in 146 147 accordance with the provisions of this act. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the 148 149 agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2003 "Personal 150 Services" appropriated level, when annualized in compliance with 151 152 the provisions of this act, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement 153 will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as 154 the requirements of this provision are met. 155 156 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 157 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law, except that no transfers shall be made which reduce funds allocated in 158 159 Section 3 to Regional Facilities or Private Prisons.
