- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 23-15-505, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- amended as follows: 6
- 7 23-15-505. The board of supervisors of any county in the
- 8 State of Mississippi and the governing authorities of any
- municipality in the State of Mississippi are hereby authorized and 9
- empowered, in their discretion, to purchase or rent optical mark 10
- reading equipment used in an electronic voting system which meets 11
- the requirements of Section 23-15-507 and may use such system in 12
- 13 all or a part of the precincts within its boundaries. It may
- enlarge, consolidate or alter the boundaries of precincts where an 14
- 15 electronic voting system is used. The provisions of this chapter
- shall be controlling with respect to elections where any OMR 16
- system is used, and shall be liberally construed so as to carry 17
- 18 out the purpose of this chapter. The provisions of the election
- law relating to the conduct of elections with paper ballots, that 19
- are to be manually tabulated, insofar as they are applicable and 20
- 21 not in conflict with the efficient conduct of the systems, shall

- The Board of Supervisors of Jasper County shall purchase 23
- optical mark reading equipment to scan ballots at the polling 24
- places, provided that such purchase is paid for out of federal 25
- 26 funds administered and made available through the Office of the

28	SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
29	shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
30	or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
31	Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
32	District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
33	provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
34	extended.

35 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
