- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4
- SECTION 1. No law enforcement officer shall engage in a 5
- pursuit in a motor vehicle to apprehend a violator of a 6
- misdemeanor traffic offense. Motor vehicle pursuits are 7
- 8 authorized to apprehend felons who attempt to flee or elude a law
- enforcement officer. 9
- SECTION 2. Section 63-3-205, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10
- amended as follows: 11
- 63-3-205. The provisions of this chapter applicable to the 12
- 13 drivers of vehicles upon the highways shall apply to the drivers
- of all vehicles owned or operated by the United States, this state 14
- 15 or any county, city, town, district, or any other political
- subdivision of the state, subject to such specific exceptions as 16
- are set forth in this chapter with respect to authorized emergency 17
- 18 vehicles.
- The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to persons, 19
- teams, motor vehicles and other equipment while actually engaged 20
- 21 in work upon the surface of a highway but shall apply to such
- persons and vehicles when traveling to or from such work. 22
- No driver of any authorized emergency vehicle shall assume 23
- any special privilege under this chapter except when such vehicle 24
- is operated in response to an emergency call or in the immediate 25
- 26 pursuit of an actual or suspected violator of the law, excluding
- 27 traffic violations.

28 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

29 and after July 1, 2003.
