HOUSE BILL NO. 1454

AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL 1 FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF 2 MATCHING FEDERAL FUNDS TO MAXIMIZE FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR THE HIRING 3 4 OF ADDITIONAL SOCIAL WORKERS, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums heretofore 6 appropriated, the following sum, or so much of it as may be 7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 8 9 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the expenses of the Department of Human Services for the period beginning upon passage 10 and ending June 30, 2003..... \$650,000.00. 11 SECTION 2. This additional appropriation is made for the 12 purpose of authorizing state funds to match federal funds for the 13 hiring of additional social workers at the Department of Human 14 Services. The State General Funds appropriated by this act 15 represent funds transferred into the State General Fund by 16 Attorney General Mike Moore resulting from a settlement in a 17 multistate investigation of Bridgestone/Firestone. Not less than 18 One Hundred Eighty-seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars 19 (\$187,500.00) of the funds appropriated by this act shall be 20 allocated to counties in which social worker case loads are in 21 excess of one hundred (100) cases per social worker as reported by 22 the most recent survey of the Mississippi Chapter of the National 23 Association of Social Workers. The department may establish up to 24 forty-two (42) new full-time, permanent DHS-social-worker 25 26 positions as necessary to ensure that average case loads per social worker do not exceed fifty (50) cases. The department may 27 28 escalate budget and expend special funds received from any source H. B. No. 1454 A1/203/HR03/R1682

to carry out the provisions of this act. If funds made available through this act are not adequate to ensure that average case loads per social worker do not exceed fifty (50) cases, the department may maintain case loads above this level provided that funds are allocated to counties with the greatest need as determined by the most recent survey of case loads per social worker.

36 SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 37 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or 38 funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State 39 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his 40 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or 41 officers in the manner provided by law.

42 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 43 and after its passage and through June 30, 2003.
