## HOUSE BILL NO. 1457

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-7-201, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2	TO PROVIDE THAT PROCEEDINGS TO ESTABLISH A PRIVATE WAY OF
3	NECESSITY THROUGH THE LANDS OF ANOTHER FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOWING
4	INGRESS AND EGRESS SHALL BE FILED WITH AND DETERMINED BY THE
5	CIRCUIT COURT OF THE COUNTY WHERE THE LAND IS LOCATED; AND FOR

- 6 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 65-7-201, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 65-7-201. When any person shall desire to have a private
- 11 road laid out through the land of another, when necessary for
- 12 ingress and egress, he shall apply by petition, stating the facts
- 13 and reasons, to the <u>circuit court</u> of the county <u>where the land is</u>
- 14 <u>located</u>, and the court shall determine the reasonableness of the
- 15 application. The owner of the property shall be a necessary party
- 16 to the proceedings. If the court finds in favor of the
- 17 petitioner, all damages that the court determines that the
- 18 landowner should be compensated for shall be assessed against and
- 19 shall be paid by the person applying for the private road, and he
- 20 shall pay all the costs and expenses incurred in the proceedings.
- 21 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after its passage.
