HOUSE BILL NO. 1507

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 1 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE TOMBIGBEE RIVER VALLEY 2 WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2004. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out 6 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available 7 to the Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District, for the 8 purpose of paying bond maturities, accrued interest, maintenance 9 expenses, project development costs, and any other authorized 10 expenses of the water management district, for the fiscal year 11 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 12 13\$ 3,135,810.00. SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 14 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be 15 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 16 expenditure: 17 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 18 Personal Services: 19 20 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 679,895.00 21 Travel and Subsistence..... 43,615.00 22 Contractual Services..... 200,000.00 Commodities..... 167,000.00 23 Capital Outlay: 24 Other Than Equipment..... 1,325,000.00 25 26 Equipment..... 510,300.00 27 Subsidies, Loans and Grants..... 210,000.00

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With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 35 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 36 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 37 38 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 39 40 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 41 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 42 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 43 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 44 act. 45 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 46 47 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 48 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 49 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 51 52 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 53 54 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. 56

57 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 58 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 59 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 60 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

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SECTION 3. Of the funds provided under the provisions of 61 this act, Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$17,000.00) may be used to 62 reallocate or reclassify existing positions of this agency. 63 64 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 65 of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance 66 Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and 67 Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for 68 the health insurance plan. 69

SECTION 5. All monies in possession of the district in excess of necessary operating funds shall be deposited with a bank or banks selected by the board of directors of the district. These funds shall be deposited in such bank or banks and in such manner that interest earned shall be at least equal to interest earnings on state funds deposited by the State Treasury.

76 **SECTION 6.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 77 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 78 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

79 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 80 and after July 1, 2003.
