HOUSE BILL NO. 1517

AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 1 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD OF 2 3 REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS FOR 4 FISCAL YEAR 2004. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. 32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 37 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 38 39 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 40 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 41 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 44 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 45 46 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 47 48 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 49 50 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 51 52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 53 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. 54

55 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

59 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 60 of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for 61 increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance

Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and
Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for
the health insurance plan.

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 65 SECTION 4. 66 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 67 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 68 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 69 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 70 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 71 72 and after July 1, 2003.
