5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Nursing
9	Home Administrators for the purpose of defraying the expenses of
LO	the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending
L1	June 30, 2004\$ 143,430.00.
L2	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
L3	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
L4	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
L5	Permanent: Full Time 2
L6	Part Time 0
L7	Time-Limited: Full Time0
L8	Part Time0
L9	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
20	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
21	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
22	Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004
23	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
24	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the
25	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
26	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
27	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
28	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
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- 29 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 30 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 31 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal
- 32 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
- 33 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
- 34 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
- 35 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"
- 36 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 37 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 38 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 39 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 40 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 41 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 43 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 44 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 45 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 46 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 47 of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for
- 48 increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance
- 49 Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and
- 50 Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for
- 51 the health insurance plan.
- 52 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 53 Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home Administrators deposit all
- 54 revenue generated into a special fund in the State Treasury to the
- 55 credit of the Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home
- 56 Administrators and that all interest earned or deposited to the
- 57 fund shall remain in the fund and not be paid into the State
- 58 General Fund of Mississippi.
- 59 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 60 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 61 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

- 62 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 63 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 64 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 65 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 66 and after July 1, 2003.
