HOUSE BILL NO. 1524

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE ADMINISTRATIVE 2 EXPENSES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' 3 4 RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM BUILDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2004. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of 9 the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of 10 defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of 11 the Public Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in 12 the State Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building 13 14 Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System 15 Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending 16 June 30, 2004.....\$ 9,575,547.00. 17 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 18 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be 19 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 20 expenditure: 21 22 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 23 Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 24 5,941,207.00 Travel and Subsistence..... 75,000.00 25 Contractual Services..... 2,936,190.00 26 300,000.00 27 Commodities..... 28 Capital Outlay:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 38 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 40 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 41 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 43 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 44 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 45 46 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 47 48 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 49 50 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 51 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 52 53 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 54 55 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 56 57 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 58 59 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
allocated in Section 2 in the category "Personal Services:
Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," not more than Fifty Thousand
Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be used to pay overtime compensation
for work on data processing records after regular office hours.

SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 70 71 necessary, while remaining within the project cost of Sixteen Million Four Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-five 72 73 Dollars (\$16,432,885.00) is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Building Fund Expense 74 75 Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose 76 of construction and renovation to the existing building and parking facilities located at 429 Mississippi Street in Jackson, 77 78 Mississippi, including architectural fees and furnishings, as well as associated moving expenses and to provide monies for the lease 79 80 of facilities while the construction/renovation is underway, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004 81 82\$15,331,650.00.

The expenditure of funds appropriated under this section shall be subject to the approval of the Department of Finance and Administration, and the Department of Finance and Administration shall submit an annual report regarding such expenditures to the Legislative Budget Office, the House Public Buildings, Grounds and Lands Committee and the Senate Public Property Committee.

89 SECTION 5. In accordance with the purposes of this article, 90 there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public 91 Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund, 92 into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income 93 from the building owned by the system located at 301 North

H. B. No. 1524 03/HR05/A531 PAGE 3 (RM\ST) 94 President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal 95 year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the 96 Administrative Budget Fund of the system.

97 It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have 98 the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System 99 Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed 100 One Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00) for repair 101 and maintenance of the buildings owned by the system. All expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building 102 Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this 103 104 article and for the purposes designated herein.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for the health insurance plan.

111 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 112 113 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 114 115 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 116 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 117 118 and after July 1, 2003.
