- 67 (\$7,320.00).
- 68 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 69 of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for
- 70 increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance
- 71 Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and
- 72 Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for
- 73 the health insurance plan.
