HOUSE BILL NO. 1528

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 1 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 3 MISSISSIPPI REAL ESTATE APPRAISER LICENSING AND CERTIFICATION 4 BOARD FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2004. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 Treasury to the credit of the Real Estate Appraisal License Fund, 8 9 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board for the fiscal 10 year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 11 12\$ 347,392.00. SECTION 2. 33 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 38 39 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 41 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 42 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 45 46 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 47 48 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 49 50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 51 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 52 53 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 54 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 56

57 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 58 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 59 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

60 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of 61 this act, Fourteen Thousand One Hundred Sixty-four Dollars

64 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 65 of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for 66 increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance 67 Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and 68 Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for 69 the health insurance plan.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

76 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 77 and after July 1, 2003.
