HOUSE BILL NO. 1531

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2004.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial
Stadium Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission for the fiscal
year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004
\$ 1,312,026.00.
In addition to the funds appropriated herein, the Mississippi
Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission is hereby authorized to
disburse to participating institutions, agencies or departments
their shares or divisions of gate receipts.
SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
expenditure:

40	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
41	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
42	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
43	Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004
44	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
45	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the
46	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
47	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
48	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
49	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
50	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
51	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
52	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal
53	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
54	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
55	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
56	annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services"
57	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
58	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
59	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
60	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
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- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 62 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 64 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 67 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for
- 69 increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance
- 70 Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and
- 71 Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for
- 72 the health insurance plan.
- 73 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 74 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 75 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 76 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 77 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 78 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 79 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 80 and after July 1, 2003.
