1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2004.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004
10	\$ 29,826,365.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department
14	of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by
15	or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of
16	defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004
18	\$ 186,125,788.00.
19	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
20	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
21	Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the
22	purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board of Health for
23	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.

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96 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
97 State Department of Health may escalate any special funds and
98 positions not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00). Such
99 escalation shall be submitted to and approved by the Department of
100 Finance and Administration in the manner consistent with the

Department of Health shall have the authority to expend any special funds collected or otherwise available, notwithstanding any restrictions in the general law or statutes earmarking said funds for a particular use, that are in excess of the amounts needed for the purpose of such fund, for the purpose of providing maternal and child health, family planning and disease control services.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that with the funds provided herein, the State Department of Health may provide and administer without charge, Hepatitis B vaccinations to Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel who are in need of such vaccinations through job related exposure.

115 SECTION 8. In addition to all other sums heretofore appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 116 117 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 118 Treasury to the credit of the Local Governments and Rural Water Systems Emergency Loan Fund, and the Local Governments and Rural 119 Water System Improvements Revolving Loan Fund as authorized in 120 Chapter 521, Laws of 1995, to the State Department of Health for 121 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Local Governments and 122 Rural Water Systems Improvements Board, for the fiscal year 123 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 124 125 \$

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that in 126 the event that there are insufficient Child Care Development Block 127 Grant Funds, then the Department of Health shall maintain the 128 129 Child Care Licensure Program at the same level that the program 130 was in Fiscal Year 1993 using any other funds. 131 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall come from the Department of 132 Human Services, Child Care Development Fund or other appropriate 133 special funds for the purpose of child care licensure. 134 funds are to be transferred to the State Department of Health no 135 136 later than July 31, 2003. The State Department of Health shall make a complete accounting of the uses of these funds to the 137 138 Department of Human Services. SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 139 State Department of Health shall expend not more than Fifty 140 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of the funds appropriated in Section 141 1 and allocated in Section 4 for providing the oil known as 142 143 "Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents 144 145 over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the 146 147 cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed pathology and biannual MRI exams. 148 SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore 149 150 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in 151 152 the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as authorized in the case Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State 153 of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery 154

Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429) to the

State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning

July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004.....\$

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- It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds 158 159 appropriated in this section, an amount of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) is provided to fund the 160 161 School Tobacco Nurse Program. 162 SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) are provided for the 163 purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs only and not for educational 164 165 purposes. Of the funds appropriated in Section 3, the 166 SECTION 14. amounts of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) 167 168 shall be allocated to the T. K. Martin Center at Mississippi State University and One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars 169 (\$125,000.00) shall be allocated to the Regional Rehabilitation 170 Center in Tupelo for the Early Intervention Program. 171 SECTION 15. In addition to all other funds heretofore 174 175 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 176 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department 177 of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by 178 179 or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of funding the Federal Bioterrorism Preparedness Program to the State 180 Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, 181 182 and ending June 30, 2004.....\$ SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 183 184 of the funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for increased charges for State and School Employees' Health Insurance 185 Plan premium rates assessed by the Department of Finance and 186
- SECTION 18. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

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the health insurance plan.

Administration in excess of the Fiscal Year 2003 premium rates for

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 19. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2003.
