HOUSE BILL NO. 1544 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE FISCAL 2 3 YEARS 2003 AND 2004. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 7 defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the 8 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 9 \$ 29,891,091.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 12 13 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by 14 or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of 15 defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year 16 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 17\$ 201,614,093.00. 18 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 19 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 20 21 Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board of Health for 22 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004. 23\$ 14,150,000.00. 24 The above funds shall be allocated as follows: 25 26 Maternal and Child Health Care 27 Program.....\$1,400,000.00

It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the Six 33 Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00) authorized herein for the Trauma 34 Care System shall be expended to the benefit of any hospital 35 located outside the boundaries of the State of Mississippi, unless 36 otherwise excepted in this paragraph. Further, unless otherwise 37 38 excepted in this paragraph, no such out-of-state hospital shall be authorized to receive such funds until such time as the amount 39 appropriated for such purpose shall reach an amount of Eight 40 Million Dollars (\$8,000,000.00) or more. Funds shall be expended 41 by the Mississippi Department of Health for distribution to the 42 Regional Medical Center at Memphis, located in Memphis, Tennessee, 43 for their participation in the Trauma Care System. 44

45 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 46 Sections 1, 2 and 3, not more than the amounts set forth below 47 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 48 expenditure:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 69 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 70 71 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2005 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2004 72 73 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2005 budget by the 74 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 75 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 76 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 77 78 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 79 act. 80 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal 81 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 82 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 83 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 84 85 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 86 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 87 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 88 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 89 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 90

91 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall beused to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

96 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 97 State Department of Health may escalate any special funds and 98 positions not to exceed Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00). 99 Such escalation shall be submitted to and approved by the 100 Department of Finance and Administration in the manner consistent 101 with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 102 Department of Health shall have the authority to expend any 103 104 special funds collected or otherwise available, notwithstanding any restrictions in the general law or statutes earmarking said 105 106 funds for a particular use, that are in excess of the amounts 107 needed for the purpose of such fund, for the purpose of providing maternal and child health, family planning and disease control 108 109 services.

110 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that with 111 the funds provided herein, the State Department of Health may 112 provide and administer without charge, Hepatitis B vaccinations to 113 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel who are in need of such 114 vaccinations through job related exposure.

115 SECTION 8. In addition to all other sums heretofore appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 116 117 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 118 Treasury to the credit of the Local Governments and Rural Water Systems Emergency Loan Fund, and the Local Governments and Rural 119 120 Water System Improvements Revolving Loan Fund as authorized in Chapter 521, Laws of 1995, to the State Department of Health for 121 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Local Governments and 122 Rural Water Systems Improvements Board, for the fiscal year 123 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... 124 125\$ 33,552,000.00.

131 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall come from the Department of 132 Human Services, Child Care Development Fund or other appropriate 133 special funds for the purpose of child care licensure. 134 These funds are to be transferred to the State Department of Health no 135 136 later than July 31, 2003. The State Department of Health shall make a complete accounting of the uses of these funds to the 137 138 Department of Human Services.

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 139 State Department of Health shall expend not more than Fifty 140 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of the funds appropriated in Section 141 1 and allocated in Section 4 for providing the oil known as 142 143 "Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents 144 145 over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the 146 147 cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed pathology and biannual MRI exams. 148

SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore 149 150 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in 151 152 the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as authorized in the case Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State 153 of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery 154 155 Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429) to the 156 State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning 157 July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 8,000,000.00.

162 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven 163 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) are provided for the 164 purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs and other necessary AIDS related 165 medical services.

SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 3, the amounts of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be allocated to the T. K. Martin Center at Mississippi State University and One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be allocated to the Regional Rehabilitation Center in Tupelo for the Early Intervention Program.

172SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand173Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Osteoporosis Program.

SECTION 16. In addition to all other funds heretofore 174 175 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special 176 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department 177 of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by 178 179 or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of 180 funding the Federal Bioterrorism Preparedness Program to the State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2003, 181 182 and ending June 30, 2004..... \$ 12,300,000.00.

SECTION 17. Of the funds provided under the provisions of this act, Two Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$277,373.00) may be used to reallocate or reclassify existing positions of this agency.

187 **SECTION 18.** In addition to all other sums heretofore 188 appropriated, an amount not to exceed the following sum is 189 appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit 190 of the State Department of Health, for the purpose of providing

The amount of funds provided to the Regional Medical Center at Memphis under this section shall not exceed the actual amount determined by the State Department of Health's distribution formula for trauma fund disbursements.

In order to receive the funds provided under this section, the Regional Medical Center at Memphis shall provide to the State Department of Health such data regarding trauma services and payments as required by the department in accordance with the submission schedule established by the department.

203 **SECTION 19.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 204 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 205 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 206 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 207 208 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from 209 210 and after July 1, 2003, except for Section 18 which shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. 211
