HOUSE BILL NO. 1654

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF  
2 MAGEE, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF  
3 SUPERVISORS OF SIMPSON COUNTY FOR THE PURCHASE AND RENOVATION OF  
4 THE BUILDING AND REAL ESTATE FORMERLY OWNED BY WAL-MART STORES IN  
5 THE CITY OF MAGEE; TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE  
6 CITY OF MAGEE TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
7 SIMPSON COUNTY OR TO COPIAH-LINCOLN COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR THE  
8 MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF COPIAH-LINCOLN COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
9 FACILITIES IN SIMPSON COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

11 **SECTION 1.** (1) The governing authorities of the City of  
12 Magee, Mississippi, in their discretion, may contribute to the  
13 Board of Supervisors of Simpson County, Mississippi, out of any  
14 available funds, an amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand  
15 Dollars (\$35,000.00) in fiscal year 2004, to be used by the county  
16 (a) for the purchase, renovation, furnishing and equipping of the  
17 building and real estate formerly owned by Wal-Mart Stores in the  
18 City of Magee, or (b) if the building and real estate formerly  
19 owned by Wal-Mart Stores in the City of Magee is no longer  
20 available for purchase by the county, for the purchase of other  
21 real estate in the county and the construction, furnishing and  
22 equipping of a building on the property, as provided in House Bill  
23 No. 1644, 2003 Regular Session.

24 (2) The governing authorities of the City of Magee,  
25 Mississippi, in their discretion, may contribute funds to the  
26 Board of Supervisors of Simpson County, Mississippi, or to  
27 Copiah-Lincoln Community College, or to both, out of any available  
28 funds, for the maintenance and operation of the Copiah-Lincoln  
29 Community College facilities in Simpson County.



30           **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
31 and after its passage.
