HOUSE BILL NO. 1660

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT TO ESTABLISH THE PAYMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL BENEFIT EACH 3 YEAR TO ALL RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND FOR FIREMEN AND POLICEMEN OR BENEFICIARIES THEREOF WHO ARE RECEIVING A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE ADDITIONAL BENEFIT SHALL BE BASED ON EACH FULL FISCAL YEAR AFTER 6 7 JUNE 30, 2002, THAT THE MEMBER OR BENEFICIARY THEREOF HAS ACTUALLY DRAWN RETIREMENT PAYMENTS FROM THE DATE OF RETIREMENT; TO PROVIDE 8 THAT THE AMOUNT OF THE ADDITIONAL BENEFIT WILL BE EQUAL TO THE 9 ANNUAL PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, BUT NOT MORE 10 11 THAN 3% IN ANY ONE YEAR, MULTIPLIED BY THE ANNUAL RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE ADDITIONAL BENEFIT SHALL BE CUMULATIVE SO THAT NO RETIREE OR BENEFICIARY WILL RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL BENEFIT IN ANY YEAR THAT IS LESS THAN THE ADDITIONAL 12 13 14 BENEFIT RECEIVED IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR; TO PROVIDE THAT THE 15 16 CUMULATIVE PERCENTAGE OF THE ADDITIONAL BENEFIT SHALL NOT EXCEED 27%; TO PROVIDE THAT FOR THOSE MEMBERS WHO RETIRED BEFORE JULY 1, 17 18 2001, AND BENEFICIARIES THEREOF, THE ADDITIONAL BENEFIT SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO THE ADDITIONAL PAYMENT RECEIVED IN FISCAL YEAR 2002 19 20 UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 926 OR 934, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2001; TO PROVIDE THAT THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF 21 GULFPORT MAY PROVIDE A ONE-TIME AD HOC INCREASE IN THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF ALL RETIREES OF THE CITY OF GULFPORT DISABILITY AND 22 23 RELIEF FUND FOR FIREMEN AND POLICEMEN WHO RETIRED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 2.4 25 1, 2001; TO PROVIDE THAT THE ADDITIONAL BENEFIT AND THE AD HOC BENEFIT INCREASE SHALL NOT BE MADE UNLESS THE DISABILITY AND 26 RELIEF FUND CURRENTLY IS ACTUARIALLY SOUND AND WILL REMAIN 27 ACTUARIALLY SOUND IF THE ADDITIONAL BENEFIT AND THE AD HOC BENEFIT 28 INCREASE ARE MADE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 30 31 **SECTION 1.** (1) (a) Subject to the provisions of subsection (4) of this section, the governing authorities of the City of 32 Gulfport, Mississippi, in their discretion, may establish the 34 payment of an additional benefit each year, on December 1 or July 1 of the year as provided in subsection (3) of this section, to 35 all retired members of the City of Gulfport Disability and Relief 36 Fund for Firemen and Policemen, or beneficiaries thereof, who are 37 receiving a retirement or disability allowance under any provision 38

of Section 21-29-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

additional benefit shall be made from monies accumulated in the

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- 41 City of Gulfport Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and
- 42 Policemen.
- 43 (b) In order to qualify for the additional benefit, the
- 44 retiree or beneficiary must have received monthly retirement or
- 45 disability payments for at least one (1) full fiscal year, from
- 46 July 1 through June 30. The additional benefit shall be based on
- 47 each full fiscal year after June 30, 2002, that the member or
- 48 beneficiary thereof has actually drawn retirement or disability
- 49 payments from the date of retirement.
- 50 (c) Beginning with fiscal year 2003, the amount of the
- 51 additional benefit will be equal to the annual percentage change
- 52 in the Consumer Price Index (CPI), as set by the United States
- 53 Department of Labor, but not more than three percent (3%) in any
- one (1) year, multiplied by the annual retirement or disability
- 55 allowance. The annual percentage change in the CPI shall be
- 56 calculated using the greater of the change for the period from
- 57 July 1 through June 30 of the fiscal year preceding payment of the
- 58 additional benefit or the period from January 1 through December
- 59 31 of the calendar year preceding payment in any fiscal year in
- 60 which an additional benefit is payable. The additional benefit
- 61 shall be cumulative so that no retiree or beneficiary will receive
- 62 an additional benefit in any year that is less than the additional
- 63 benefit received in the previous year. The cumulative percentage
- of the additional benefit provided for in this section shall not
- 65 exceed twenty-seven percent (27%).
- (d) For those members who retired before July 1, 2001,
- 67 and beneficiaries thereof, the additional benefit provided for in
- 68 this section shall be in addition to the additional payment
- 69 received in fiscal year 2002 under the provisions of Chapter 926
- 70 or 934, Local and Private Laws of 2001. However, those retired
- 71 members and beneficiaries shall not earn any additional percentage
- 72 under the provisions of Chapter 926 or 934, Local and Private Laws
- 73 of 2001, for fiscal years in retirement after June 30, 2002. The

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percentage of the additional payment made in fiscal year 2002
under the provisions of Chapter 926 or 934, Local and Private Laws
of 2001, shall be included in the total cumulative percentage
calculation that those retired members and beneficiaries will
receive beginning with the initial payment of the additional
benefit under this section, but shall not be included in the
twenty-seven percent (27%) limitation of paragraph (c) of this

subsection.

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- (2) Subject to the provisions of subsection (4) of this section, the governing authorities of the City of Gulfport,
 Mississippi, in their discretion, may provide a one-time ad hoc increase in the retirement or disability allowance of all retirees of the City of Gulfport Disability and Relief Fund for Firemen and Policemen who retired before September 1, 2001, and beneficiaries thereof, in an amount equal to Two Dollars (\$2.00) per month for each year of service before retirement, plus Two Dollars (\$2.00) per month for each fiscal year in retirement as of the date of payment. The fiscal year used in the calculation of the ad hoc increase shall be the fiscal year used by the City of Gulfport, which is from October 1 through September 30.
- The additional benefit authorized under subsection (1) 94 (3) 95 of this section shall be paid in one (1) payment in December of each year to those persons who are receiving a retirement or 96 disability allowance on December 1 of that year, unless an 97 98 election is made under this subsection. Persons receiving a retirement or disability allowance on July 1 of the year may 99 100 elect, by an irrevocable agreement in writing filed in the office of the Public Employees' Retirement System not later than thirty 101 (30) days before July 1 of the year, to receive the additional 102 benefit in not less than twelve (12) equal monthly installments 103 each year beginning on July 1 of the year. 104 This irrevocable 105 agreement shall be binding on the retired member and any 106 subsequent beneficiaries. Payment of the monthly installments

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- 107 shall not extend beyond the month in which a retirement or
- 108 disability allowance is due and payable. If a person who is
- 109 receiving monthly installments dies, any remaining amounts shall
- 110 be paid in a lump sum to the designated beneficiaries.
- 111 (4) The additional benefit and the ad hoc benefit increase
- 112 authorized under this section shall not be made unless:
- 113 (a) The City of Gulfport Disability and Relief Fund for
- 114 Firemen and Policemen is actuarially sound, as shown by the most
- 115 recent actuarial study required by Section 21-29-119, Mississippi
- 116 Code of 1972; and
- 117 (b) The disability and relief fund will remain
- 118 actuarially sound if the additional benefit and ad hoc benefit
- 119 increase authorized under this section are made, as shown by a
- 120 certified statement from the actuarial firm that prepared the most
- 121 recent actuarial study.
- 122 (5) The Board of Trustees of the Public Employees'
- 123 Retirement System shall pay the additional benefit and ad hoc
- 124 benefit increase to the persons authorized and entitled to receive
- 125 the benefit and the increase, after all of the following
- 126 conditions have been met:
- 127 (a) The governing authorities of the City of Gulfport
- 128 must adopt a resolution to establish the additional benefit and
- 129 the ad hoc benefit increase authorized under this section and
- 130 transmit the resolution to the board of trustees;
- 131 (b) The advisory board provided for in Section
- 132 21-29-105, Mississippi Code of 1972, must adopt a resolution
- 133 supporting the establishment of the additional benefit and the ad
- 134 hoc benefit increase and transmit the resolution to the board of
- 135 trustees; and
- 136 (c) The board of trustees must receive the resolutions
- 137 from the governing authorities and advisory board, and receive the
- 138 most recent actuarial study of the disability and relief fund and
- 139 the certified statement from the actuarial firm that the fund will

- 140 remain actuarially sound if the additional benefit and ad hoc
- 141 benefit increase are made.
- 142 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 143 and after July 1, 2003.
