- 9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 10 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 11 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 12 state:
- 13 Amend Section 109, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 14 as follows:
- "Section 109. $\underline{(1)}$ No public officer or member of the
- 16 Legislature shall be interested, directly or indirectly, in any
- 17 contract with the state, or any district, county, city, or town
- 18 thereof, authorized by any law passed or order made by any board
- 19 of which he may be or may have been a member, during the term for
- 20 which he shall have been chosen, or within one (1) year after the
- 21 expiration of such term.
- 22 (2) A public officer or member of the Legislature shall not
- 23 be construed as having an interest in a contract in violation of
- 24 this section if no part of the funds for the contract were
- 25 appropriated or authorized by the board or body of which the
- officer or legislator is or was a member."
- 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be
- 28 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
- 29 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday

- 30 of November 2003, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution
- 31 and by general law.
- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 33 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 34 constitutional amendment provides that a public officer or member
- 35 of the Legislature shall not be construed as having an interest in
- 36 a contract in violation of the conflicts of interest section of
- 37 the Constitution if no part of the funds for the contract were
- 38 appropriated or authorized by the board or body of which the
- 39 officer or legislator is or was a member."
