HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 41

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
2 MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890 TO CREATE A NEW SECTION REQUIRING
3 THE LEGISLATURE, BY GENERAL LAW, TO ESTABLISH A MISSISSIPPI
4 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND TO PRESCRIBE ITS POWERS AND DUTIES; AND
5 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
7 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
8 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
9 state:

10 Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by creating a new
11 section to read as follows:

12 "Section _____. The Legislature, by general law, shall
13 establish a Mississippi Department of Labor and shall prescribe
14 its powers and duties."

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be
16 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
17 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday
18 of November 2003, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution
19 and by general law.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
21 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
22 constitutional amendment creates a new section of the Constitution
23 to require the Legislature, by general law, to establish a
24 Mississippi Department of Labor and to prescribe its powers and
25 duties."
