## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE 1
- MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890, BY CREATING A NEW SECTION 205A
- TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM LEVEL OF FUNDING THAT THE LEGISLATURE MUST PROVIDE FOR SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC EDUCATION; AND FOR 3

- RELATED PURPOSES. 5
- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF 6
- 7 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the 8
- 9 state:
- Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by creating a new 10
- section to read as follows: 11
- "Section 205A. The Legislature shall appropriate funds for 12
- the support and maintenance of public education, kindergarten 13
- 14 through Grade 12, the state community and junior colleges and the
- state institutions of higher learning, inclusive, at the following 15
- minimum level: 16
- For fiscal year 2006, the Legislature shall 17
- appropriate an amount that equals the percentage of the State 18
- 19 General Fund that the Legislature appropriated for public
- education for fiscal year 2005. 20
- For fiscal year 2007, and for each fiscal year 21
- 22 thereafter until the total amount appropriated for public
- education equals sixty-one percent (61%) of the State General 23
- Fund, the Legislature shall appropriate an amount that equals the 24
- amount described in paragraph (a) of this section plus an 25
- additional amount that equals one-half percent (1/2%) of the 26
- 27 amount by which the State General Fund for the fiscal year in
- which the appropriation is made exceeds the amount of the State 28

General Fund for the immediately preceding fiscal year. 29 Once the minimum amount required to be appropriated for public education 30 under this paragraph for any fiscal year reaches sixty-one percent 31 (61%) of the State General Fund, this minimum amount may not be 32 33 reduced for any subsequent fiscal year." BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be 34 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at 35 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday 36 of November 2003, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution 37 38 and by general law. 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: 40 "This proposed constitutional amendment establishes a minimum level of funding 41 that the Legislature must provide for support and maintenance of 42 public education. The amount appropriated for public education 43 for fiscal year 2006 must be not less than the percentage of the 44 State General Fund appropriated for public education for fiscal 45 year 2005. For each year thereafter, the minimum amount increases 46 by one-half percent until the amount appropriated equals sixty-one 47
