HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 84

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING DR. ROBERT BALLARD FOR HIS 1 OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS IN DEEP-OCEAN ARCHAEOLOGY AND SCIENCE. 2 3 WHEREAS, Dr. Robert Ballard, after receiving thousands of letters from school children wanting to know how he discovered the 4 RMS Titanic, founded the JASON Project in 1989, which is a 5 nonprofit educational organization working in partnership with 6 teachers, students, corporations, educational institutions and 7 government to inspire in students a lifelong passion to pursue 8 learning in science, math and technology through exploration and 9 discovery; and 10

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Ballard is the founder and head of the Institute 12 for Exploration (IFE) at Mystic Marinelife Aquarium in Mystic, 13 Connecticut, which specializes in deep-ocean archaeology and whose 14 goal is to establish this new field of research utilizing evolving 15 technology such as advanced mapping imaging systems, underwater 16 robotics and manned submersibles; and

WHEREAS, after receiving his undergraduate degree in geology and chemistry from the University of California, Dr. Ballard attended graduate school at the University of Southern California, the University of Hawaii's Graduate School of Oceanography and received his Ph.D. in marine geology and geophysics from the University of Rhode Island; and

23 WHEREAS, Dr. Ballard is also a distinguished military 24 graduate of the University of California with a Commission in Army 25 Intelligence, which was transferred to the United States Navy, and 26 he served on active duty during the Vietnam War as an Ensign,

Lieutenant J.G. and finally as a Lieutenant, then joined theUnited States Naval Reserves as a Commander; and

WHEREAS, the more than 100 deep sea expeditions Dr. Ballard has led or participated in, which included the use of the deep-diving submersibles ALVIN, ARCHIMEDE, TRIESTE II, TURTLE, BEN FRANKLIN, CYANA and NR-1, led to the discovery of high temperature "black smokers," the *R.M.S. Titanic*, the German battleship *Bismarck*, 11 warships from the lost fleet of Guadalcanal, *The U.S.S. Yorktown* and exploration of the luxury liner *Lusitania*; and

WHEREAS, not only has Dr. Ballard published over 50 36 37 scientific articles in journals including Science, Nature, Earth and Planetary Science Letters, and the Journal of Geophysical 38 Research, but he also received the Newcomb-Cleveland award from 39 the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) for 40 an article he coauthored in Science, detailing the discovery of 41 high temperature vent fields in the East Pacific Rise; and 42 WHEREAS, the books Dr. Ballard has written on his discoveries 43 of the R.M.S. Titanic, Bismarck and the Lusitania are worldwide 44 bestsellers; and 45

46 WHEREAS, Dr. Ballard is a member of Sigma Xi, Oceanography Society, Geological Society of America, Marine Technology Society, 47 48 American Association for the Advancement of Science, American Geophysical Union and The Bohemian Club, and he holds Honorary 49 Degrees from the University of Rhode Island, Clark University, 50 51 Southeastern Massachusetts University, Long Island University, Southampton, the University of Bath, England, Lehigh University, 52 Skidmore College, Worcester Polytechnic Institute, Bridgewater 53 State College, Tufts University, Lenoir-Rhyne College, Maine 54 Maritime Academy and Massachusetts Maritime Academy; and 55
