- 17 Mrs. Champion initiated the Mississippi Patent and Trademark
- 18 Depository Library Service, served as secretary of the Mississippi
- 19 Library Association (MLA) and as chair of the MLA's Special
- 20 Library Section, served as chair of the Central Mississippi
- 21 Library Council and served as a member of the Steering Committee
- 22 for the Mississippi Alliance for Gaining New Opportunities through
- 23 Library Information Access (MAGNOLIA); and

- 25 expand research services to state government agencies within
- 26 Mississippi, in particular the Legislature; and
