HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 138

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, AND THE INTRODUCTION,
3 CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE, OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND
4 SECTION 43-27-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, AS AMENDED BY HOUSE
5 BILL NO. 842, 2003 REGULAR SESSION, TO PROVIDE THAT THE NET
6 PROCEEDS FROM INCOMES DERIVED FROM LEASES AND TIMBER SALES ON
7 PROPERTY OF COLUMBIA TRAINING SCHOOL AND OAKLEY TRAINING SCHOOL
8 MAY BE USED ONLY FOR INSTRUCTIONAL PURPOSES OR OPERATIONAL
9 EXPENSES, OR BOTH, AT THE TWO INSTITUTIONS UNDER THE DEPARTMENT'S
10 JURISDICTION IN PROPORTION TO THE REVENUE DERIVED FROM EACH
11 TRAINING SCHOOL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
13 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint
14 Rules of the House and the Senate, including all the deadlines and
15 other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for
16 the purpose of requesting the drafting, and the introduction,
17 consideration and passage, of a bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND
18 SECTION 43-27-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, AS AMENDED BY HOUSE
19 BILL NO. 842, 2003 REGULAR SESSION, TO PROVIDE THAT THE NET
20 PROCEEDS FROM INCOMES DERIVED FROM LEASES AND TIMBER SALES ON
21 PROPERTY OF COLUMBIA TRAINING SCHOOL AND OAKLEY TRAINING SCHOOL
22 MAY BE USED ONLY FOR INSTRUCTIONAL PURPOSES OR OPERATIONAL
23 EXPENSES, OR BOTH, AT THE TWO INSTITUTIONS UNDER THE DEPARTMENT'S
24 JURISDICTION IN PROPORTION TO THE REVENUE DERIVED FROM EACH
25 TRAINING SCHOOL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
