- 18 impressive 26-5 record, a second conference title, and earned a

- 21 honoree, coached with the United States Basketball team with the
- U.S. Olympic Festival in 1989, and again in 1992, for the Women's
- 23 Select Team that won the gold medal in the R. William Jones Cup in
- 24 Taipei, Taiwan; and
- 25 WHEREAS, with twenty-seven years of coaching experience,
- 26 twenty-two of which were spent at USM, Ms. James coached with the
- 27 1995 USA Basketball World University Games women's team that won a
