HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 27

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING LYDIA RICE ON
2 BEING SELECTED AS A 2002 STATE GAMES ATHLETE OF THE YEAR.

3 WHEREAS, Lydia Rice of Tupelo, Mississippi, was selected as a
4 2002 State Games of Mississippi Athlete of the Year; and

5 WHEREAS, the award seeks to honor those athletes who
6 personify the ideals of the State Games movement, such as
7 participation, sportsmanship, achievement, effort and positive
8 attitude; and

9 WHEREAS, Ms. Rice was a track and field participant in the
10 State Games of Mississippi, and her results in the 2002 games were
11 1 Silver Medal in the 400 meter and 3 Gold Medals in the 100-meter
12 hurdles, high jump and 4x100 relay; and

13 WHEREAS, having participated in the State Games of
14 Mississippi for two years, Ms. Rice recorded a new record in 2002
15 in the high jump with 4 feet, 9 inches in the 13-14-year-old
16 division, and in the 100-meter hurdles, she ran a time of 18.5
17 seconds; and

18 WHEREAS, Ms. Rice is very focused in her preparation for
19 these events and has worked hard to learn the technical aspects,
20 and is an all-around athlete having been a member of the Tupelo
21 select soccer team for several years; and

22 WHEREAS, not only is Ms. Rice an honor student and active in
23 her church youth group choir, she was an All-State Player in the
24 Mississippi High School Athletic Association 5A State
25 Cross-Country Meet, finishing 9th overall, and was also the 3rd
26 Tupelo High School runner who helped Tupelo win the 5A
27 Championship; and



28 WHEREAS, Lydia Rice demonstrates the true spirit of the State
29 Games of Mississippi as she is committed to doing her very best to
30 compete in numerous events in which she has excelled for the past
31 three years, and she enjoys the competition and has respect for
32 the athletes, volunteers, and staff who work, plan and implement
33 this annual classic; and

34 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives of
35 the State of Mississippi to recognize and commend excellence,
36 especially when evidenced by the young people of our state, who
37 are its future:
