BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6

7 SECTION 1. Section 73-6-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

amended as follows: 8

73-6-3. There is hereby created a State Board of 9

Chiropractic Examiners. This board shall consist of six (6) 10

members; one (1) of whom shall be the executive officer of the 11

State Board of Health, or his designee, and one (1) from each 12

congressional district as presently constituted, to be appointed 13

14 by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.

member except the executive officer of the State Board of Health 15

shall be a qualified elector of the State of Mississippi having 16

been continuously engaged in the practice of chiropractic in 17

Mississippi for at least five (5) years prior to appointment. No 18

member shall be a stockholder in or member of the faculty or board 19

of trustees of any school of chiropractic. Each member appointed 20

to the board shall serve for five (5) years and until his 21

22 successor is appointed and qualified; except the terms of the

23 initial members appointed by the Governor shall expire one (1)

each for five (5) years or until their successors are appointed 24

The members of the board as constituted on January 25 and qualified.

1, 2003, whose terms have not expired shall serve the balance of 26

27 their terms, after which time the membership of the board shall be

appointed as follows: There shall be appointed one (1) member of 28

- 29 the board from each of the four (4) Mississippi congressional
- 30 districts as they currently exist, and one (1) from the state at
- 31 large, and the Governor shall make appointments from the
- 32 <u>congressional district having the smallest number of board members</u>
- 33 until the membership includes one (1) member from each district as
- 34 required. Vacancies on the board, except for the executive
- 35 officer of the State Board of Health, or his designee, shall be
- 36 filled by appointment of the Governor only for unexpired terms.
- 37 Any member who shall not attend two (2) consecutive meetings of
- 38 the board shall be subject to removal by the Governor. The
- 39 chairman of the board shall notify the Governor in writing when
- 40 any such member has failed to attend two (2) consecutive regular
- 41 meetings.
- 42 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after July 1, 2003.
