- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 7-5-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 7-5-39. The Attorney General shall also represent the state,
- 8 in person or by his assistant, as counsel in all suits against the
- 9 state in other courts than the Supreme Court at the seat of
- 10 government, and he shall, in like manner, act as counsel for any
- 11 of the state officers in suits brought by or against them in their
- 12 official capacity, touching any official duty or trust and triable
- 13 at the seat of government. He may pursue the collection of any
- 14 claim or judgment in favor of the state outside of the state.
- 15 The Attorney General may approve the hiring of outside counsel
- 16 when otherwise authorized by law only after first rendering his
- 17 written opinion pursuant to Section 7-5-25 as to the merits of the
- 18 claim or controversy.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2003.
