- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-8, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 REQUIRE THE COMMISSION ON WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO CHARGE 2
- RECIPROCAL FEES FOR A NONRESIDENT HUNTING LICENSE; AND FOR RELATED 3
- 4 PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 49-7-8, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 49-7-8. (1) No nonresident sixteen (16) years of age or 8
- 9 older may hunt, fish, kill, take or trap any game animal, bird or
- fish without having acquired and having in his immediate 10
- possession a valid license issued by the Mississippi Commission on 11
- Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. 12
- (2) The commission shall have the following duties and 13
- powers: 14
- To prescribe the forms and types of nonresident 15 (a)
- licenses that a nonresident must obtain; 16
- 17 (b) To determine the total number of each type of
- nonresident license to be issued annually; 18
- (c) To establish fees for nonresident licenses and 19
- the collection fees for the agent issuing such licenses. * * * 20
- The fee for a nonresident all game hunting license shall not be 21
- less than Sixty Dollars (\$60.00), except if a state charges 22
- Mississippi residents a higher fee, then the commission shall 23
- require an equal fee for residents of that state; 24
- To exercise all incidental powers necessary to 25
- 26 develop a nonresident licensing program.

27 (3) A nonresident who violates this section or any
28 licensing regulation of the commission is guilty of a misdemeanor
29 and shall be punished as provided in Section 49-7-21 * * *.
30 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
31 and after July 1, 2003.
