SENATE BILL NO. 2058

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-9-29, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 PROVIDE FOR THE ALLOCATION AND MATCHING OF FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY 2 3 FUNDS ALLOCATED TO MISSISSIPPI UNDER THE TRANSPORTATION EQUITY ACT 4 FOR THE TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY (TEA-21); TO AMEND SECTION 65-9-30, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED 5 6 PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 65-9-29, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 9 10 65-9-29. (1) Federal aid highway funds allocated to Mississippi * * * to be expended on the federal aid * * * routes 11 shall be expended as follows: 12 (a) * * * Federal aid * * * funds allocated to 13 Mississippi and to be expended on the federal aid routes shall be 14 divided between the Mississippi Department of Transportation and 15 the several counties, so that fifty percent (50%) will be matched 16 17 by the Mississippi Department of Transportation and expended on the federal aid routes on the state highway system, and fifty 18 percent (50%) matched by the counties with state aid or local 19 funds and expended on the federal aid routes in the several 20 counties. 21 (b) Such division will be made upon allocation by the 22 Division Administrator of the Federal Highway Administration. The 23 expenditure of all federal * * * funds shall be through and under 24 the Mississippi Department of Transportation, subject to and in 25 accordance with all rules and regulations and applicable laws of 26 27 the federal government. Program authorization of Public Law 105-178 (the Transportation 30 Equity Act for the Twenty-first Century, hereinafter called 31 TEA-21), shall be allocated for sub-state distribution in any area 32 33 of the state and fifty percent (50%) of the amount allocated to 34 areas with a population of less than five thousand (5,000) shall 35 be allocated to the eighty-two (82) counties of the state and administered by the Office of State Aid Road Construction. 36 (d) Not less than thirty percent (30%) of the bridge 37 replacement funds allocated to Mississippi under TEA-21 shall be 38 allocated to the eighty-two (82) counties of the state to replace 39 deficient bridges in accordance with all rules and regulations of 40 the Federal Highway Administration and administered by the Office 41 of State Aid Road Construction. 42

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44 (2) Federal aid * * * highway funds allocated to
45 Mississippi, * * * including federal bridge replacement funds and
46 other special grants made available for expenditure of county
47 roads, shall be expended as follows:

48 (a) Federal aid off-system highway funds expended on
49 state aid roads shall be matched with available state aid funds
50 and/or other available local funds, or as otherwise provided in
51 Section 65-1-70, Mississippi Code of 1972.

52 (b) Federal aid off-system highway funds available for 53 expenditure on roads not on the state aid system and not eligible 54 for inclusion on the state aid system shall be matched with 55 available local funds, or as otherwise provided in Section 65-9-17 56 or Section 65-1-70, Mississippi Code of 1972.

(c) The expenditure of all federal off-system highway
funds on county roads shall be programmed by the State Highway
Commission, subject to and in accordance with applicable federal
law, rules and regulations, and limited to such county projects as
recommended by the State Aid Engineer. The State Aid Engineer is
authorized to assign state aid personnel to administer off-system

requirements in the same manner and under the same provisions and
conditions as other projects authorized under this chapter.

66 **SECTION 2.** Section 65-9-30, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 67 amended as follows:

65-9-30. (1) The State Aid Engineer shall maintain an 68 accurate record of all federal aid highway funds, federal "safer 69 off-system" funds, and all other available federal road funds 70 allocated to the counties in accordance with the percentages set 71 out in Section 65-9-3. He shall likewise maintain an accurate 72 73 account of all state aid funds apportioned to the counties in accordance with the percentages and provisions set out in Section 74 75 27-65-75.

(2) The State Aid Engineer is hereby authorized to utilize 76 state aid funds, and federal aid highway funds allocated to the 77 counties as provided for in accordance with Section 65-9-29, and 78 federal "safer off-system" funds, and/or any other available 79 80 federal road funds allocated to Mississippi and to be expended on county roads, and allocated to the counties as provided for in 81 82 accordance with Section 65-9-29, in such amounts as he deems necessary for an orderly and effective programming of all funds 83 84 available to the counties, including an interchange of one type of funds for another type of funds when necessary; provided, however, 85 that each county shall receive, not less than annually, its pro 86 87 rata share of the combined funds so allocated; and further provided that the authority of the county boards of supervisors to 88 89 otherwise adopt construction programs is in no way circumvented. SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 90 and after July 1, 2003. 91
